

## SCRIPT Module 2

Welcome to the free online training course of the Dice.Lang project - Digital Citizenship Education and Foreign Language Learning.

This module focuses on the **Communication Dimension: global and digital literacies**.

The DiceLang framework presents **5 different dimensions**.

The Communication Dimension refers to the global and digital literacies necessary for digital citizens to communicate in the digital world, and for learners to understand, interpret, manage, share and create meaning in the growing density of digital communication channels and online media.

The Communication Dimension entails...

- 1) developing competences of listening, reading and viewing, that give learners access to digital media content and help them understand and decipher such content
- 2) developing language and communication competences that empower learners to participate fully in the analogue and digital world;
- 3) the active use and production of language in increasingly multimodal forms of expression,
- 4) student agency as they become participants of their digital environments;

We now challenge you to reflect on the Communication Dimension, namely on the dangers of misinformation and fake videos.

To complete this module you will be asked to listen to a language teacher, presenting a Teaching Unit about fake videos. Then you will be asked to suggest different resources or present possible adaptations to this Teaching Unit.
